

Ethnic People:

Bangladesh is a country of cultural and ethnic diversity, with over 54 indigenous peoples speaking at least 35 languages, along with the majority Bengali population. According to the 2011 census, the country's indigenous population numbers approximately 1,586,141, which represents 1.8% of the total population of the country.

A few of these

are Chakmas, Marmas, Tripuri, Tanchangya, Mros (Mrus or Moorangs), Khasi people, Jaintia, Garos, Manipuri, Keot (Kaibarta), Muslim tribes "Pangal" or "Pangan".

Dress of ethnic people:

People of different ethnic groups wear different clothes. Such as: Chakmas Women wear pinon and khadi (handmade) and men wear dhuti, Marmas wear (which is called *thumbui*—the lower part, and *angi*—the upper part). Tripuri women wear Rinai and Risa, They also wear a ring called Natang.

Food of ethnic people:

There are many variations in the diet of ethnic people. Garo's special food is Bamboo skewers, The Khasi tribes consider Pan-Supari to be sacred, Mros eat other foods but one of their foods is called nappi. Others also eat ordinary food.

Culture of ethnic people:

The culture of ethnic people is completely different from that of ordinary people. They usually celebrate different festivals in different seasons. But most of their cultural festivals revolve around their masters, Tripuri's main festival is Buishu. Marmas have many festivals during the year, but Sangrai is regarded as the biggest celebration among them.

Sports of ethnic people:

Dancing with various physical exercises to call ethnic people sports. They usually dance to the beat of the song. Wrestling is a popular sport for them. However, they play a special game called Jolkeli.

pastimes of ethnic people:

Hunting and fishing are their favorite pastimes. Marma men drink wine and play card games in leisure time.

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
